TCHI: A Community Success Story

In 2002, Tavistock Community Health Inc. (TCHI) was formed after a fundraising drive was initiated within our community and surrounding areas. TCHI became a non-profit, community-owned organization designed to maintain the existing building, to relieve maintenance duties from existing doctors to allow them to focus on patients, and to recruit new doctors to the area.



Today, TCHI consists of a network of health professionals providing a full range of health-care services in Tavistock and surrounding communities. TCHI has successfully recruited 3 new doctors to the area, provides care to over 7,000 patients and two local area long-term care residences, and is a teaching facility for medical students and residents from the University of Western Ontario.



Seventeen years have passed without active fundraising. TCHI must now work towards becoming sustainable.

As any homeowner knows, maintaining a building requires a financial commitment. Our aging building requires:

- An occasional fresh coat of paint to keep things looking presentable and welcoming to our patients
- Clean floors and carpets
- Refrigeration and back up generators for storing vaccines and medications
- Office furniture and appropriate seating in our waiting and examination areas
- Necessary medical supplies, like exam tables, instruments, etc
- 25 to 30 computers to maintain, as well as servers and IT connection costs
- Contractors for building maintenance such as lawn care, snow removal, parking lot coating and line painting, and general security for the building
- Roof maintenance
- Building insurance and utility costs
- Constant changes to government appointed health and safety regulations

All of these expenses have a real impact on our patients and the families that we care for.
